Can't decide what to read? Come hear about some of our current favourite titles and find out how to find the perfect book.

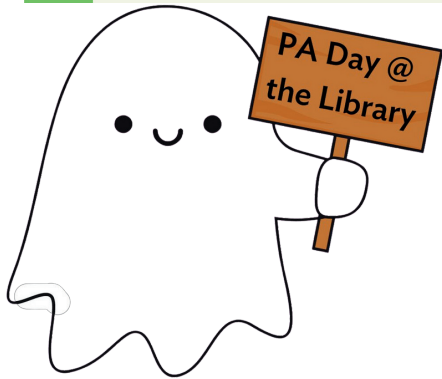
Beanstack
