Community Volunteer Income Tax Program

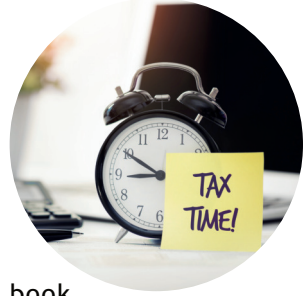
