



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights March 8, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Special Council Meeting held on March 8, 2021:

- Council deferred a report from the CAO outlining parking recommendations until additional information is presented to Council.

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Regular Council Meeting held on March 8, 2021:

- Council received a delegation from Big Brother Big Sisters Grey Bruce presenting information on their programs and how the Municipality and members of the public can become involved.
- Council approved an Encroachment Permit Application submitted by 1415747 Ontario Inc.
- Council received drinking water system reports for Lion's Head and the Tobermory Primary Place Daycare Centre and directed staff to post a notice in the Bruce Peninsula Press indicating that the Annual Reports are available for viewing at the Municipal Office or on the [municipal website](#).
- Council adopted a Municipal Lease Policy.
- Council supported a by-law to amend the Zoning By-law for a property in the former Eastnor Township.
- Council supported holding a Public Meeting on Monday, March 22, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. with respect to proposed amendments and additions to the Fees and Charges By-law.
- Council received a report regarding the Community Safety Well-Being Plan engagement survey.
- Council received a report regarding a draft Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the County of Bruce and the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula for the provision of emergency social services.
- Council supported the closure of the Municipal Office during the 2021 Christmas Holidays.

- Council supported resolutions from the Township of Archipelago and Township of Lake of Bays regarding a review of the Municipal Elections Act and capacity limits for restaurants in Stage 2 under the Reopening Ontario Act, 2020.
- Two resolutions from municipalities were received as information.
- Under Other Business, Councillor Golden indicated that there have been changes to Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) mapping in the Dyers Bay area only. She asked staff to advertise for future free skates at the Lion's Head Arena.
- Under Other Business, Councillor Myles requested that no parking be implemented on Borchardt Road leading to Devils Monument and that staff investigate if paid parking would be operational in that area based on cellphone reception.
- Several correspondence items were received as information.
- A Confirmatory By-law was passed.
- Following a Closed Session meeting, Mayor McIver advised that Council provided direction to staff with respect to the Big Tub Harbour Citizens Committee, By-law Enforcement Staff, appointment of Attainable Housing Taskforce members and Fire Chief recruitment update.
