



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights April 7, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Special Council Meeting held on April 7, 2021:

- Council received a report as information with respect to parking metre revenues and expenses from 2017 to 2020.
- Council approved the use of a food truck at the Tobermory Community Centre Parking lot for the serving of the Tobermory Community Dinner, pending Covid-19 restrictions.
- By-law 2020-71, a by-law to regulate paid parking and control traffic and more particularly the parking and stopping or standing of vehicles and the use of municipal parking lots within the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula, will be presented to Council at the April 12th, 2021 Council meeting.
- Council approved implementing paid parking in Lion's Head on certain streets.
- Council approved no parking at the end of Grant Watson Drive for access to Mermaids Cove.
- Council approved reducing parking to 25 parking spaces on the south side of Big Tub Road from 197 Big Tub Road the end of the road.
- Council approved implementing paid parking at the Dyers Bay Parking lot, if a signal can be achieved, and installing signage.
- Council approved the construction of a parking area located at 60 Carter Road.
- Council directed administration to begin discussions with Parks Canada for the lease of the parking areas located on Chi Sin Tub Dik Road and Little Cove Road.
- Council approved in principle the operation of a tourism shuttle service with Celtic Sports and Arts Centre Inc. for the 2021 tourism season.
- Council approved implementing an online parking reservation system in 2021.
- Council approved implementing paid parking on Borchardt Road and the installation of "no parking" signs along both sides of the road.
