



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights April 26, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Regular Council Meeting held on April 12, 2021:

- A Public Meeting was held regarding a proposed Zoning By-law Amendment for Application No. Z-2021-008, Porter. Members of the public expressed their support and objection to the application. Council approved the application and the necessary by-law will be placed on an upcoming Council agenda.
- A Public Meeting was held with respect to amendments to the Fees and Charges By-law. No comments were received.
- Council approved Trailer Agreements for properties located at 55 and 187 Miller Lake Shore Road and 559 Stokes Bay Road.
- Council approved a No Demand for Services Agreement for 4 Birchwood Drive.
- Council received a report on updates to the Paid Parking By-law.
- Council received a report on the Community Safety and Policing Act.
- Council approved the placement of a communication tower at the St. Edmunds Landfill and instructed Shared Tower Inc. to commence public consultation.
- Council approved Waste Management and Diversion Committee minutes.
- Council supported a resolution from the Township of Archipelago regarding road management action on invasive phragmites.
- Under Other Business, the CAO advised that the Province has yet to inform the Municipality of the status of its grant application for the Tobermory Water System. The CAO will provide Council with an update on the Isthmus Bay Road.
- Council supported a request from the Greenough Harbour Preservation Association Board for the construction of walking trails.
- Council supported a request from the Pike Bay Community Association for an Ontario Trillium Foundation grant application.
- Multiple correspondence items were received as information.
- Four by-laws were approved: Integrated Accessibility Standards Policy By-law, Agreement with the Owen Sound Police and Municipality for Dispatch

Communications By-law, Appointment of a Chief Building Official and Deputy Chief Building Official By-law, and Confirmatory By-law.
