



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights May 10, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on May 10, 2021:

- A public meeting was held regarding Official Plan Amendment L-2020-014 and Zoning By-law Amendment Z-2020-083 (Corner) for property located at 7178 Highway 6. Council adopted the Official Plan Amendment and approved the Zoning By-law Amendment.
- A public meeting was held regarding Zoning By-law Amendment Z-2020-035 (Mazzotta) for property on Pedwell Drive. Council approved the Zoning By-law Amendment.
- Paul Wagenaar, Food Security Coordinator, Unit Way of Bruce/Grey, provided a delegation to Council on measuring the size and scope of food insecurity in Bruce/Grey.
- Deryn Harkness on behalf of nine (9) Big Tub Road North residents requested changes to the Parking By-law specific to parking on Big Tub Road. A staff report will be presented at the May 25, 2021 Council meeting.
- Council approved amending the Host Servicing Agreement with eSolutions Group Limited (website provider) to reflect News module upgrades.
- Council will consider passage of a by-law at the May 25, 2021 Council meeting regarding a Site Servicing/Easement Agreement for property at 22 Legion Street.
- Council supported passage of By-law 2021-40 regarding Bruce County File No. Z-2021-008 (Porter) which will be considered at the May 25, 2021 Council meeting.
- Council supported a Grey Bruce Detachment Joint Police Board due to amendments to the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019.
- Council renewed a rental agreement with the Nature Conservancy of Canada for the building located at 5 Heron Point Road.
- Council received an approved Accounts Payable Voucher for April 2021.
- Council supported a resolution from the Town of South Bruce Peninsula with respect to lottery licensing to assist small organizations.

- Under Other Business, the CAO clarified provincial regulations included in the provincial Stay at Home Order and provided an update on the Shuttle Service Agreement with Celtic Sports and Arts Centre Inc. Council discussed management of Cabot Head Road and time restrictions at The Gap.
- Council supported the Tobermory Chamber of Commerce 2021 Canada Day Festival firework show and other correspondence items were received as information.
- Council approved six by-laws: Paid Parking By-law, 2021 Tax Rate By-law, Fees and Charges By-law, Physician Recruitment Agreement with Dr. Adam Matheson By-law, Zoning By-law Amendment (Porter), and Confirmatory By-law.
- Following a closed session meeting, Mayor McIver advised that Council received a verbal information update pertaining to the hiring of a Fire Chief and the status of the Facilities Supervisor position, which was provided by the CAO.
