



## Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights June 10, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on June 10, 2021:

- BDO Canada LLP presented the 2021 Final and Year End Audit Reports to Council.
- Mike Campbell presented the Climate Action Committee Interim Report to Council and requested building energy audits and assistance from staff.
- Harvey Rintoul requested signage to alleviate parking and congestion concerns at the Johnson Harbour boat launch ramp.
- Will Meneray, Canvas Strategy Consulting Group, presented reports regarding the short term accommodations (STA) public survey and meetings.
- Council deferred a report regarding parking on Big Tub Road.
- Council agreed to amend the Parking By-law the next time there is an update to the by-law, following a request from the Tobermory Chamber of Commerce.
- Council approved the purchase of four mobile ticket printers to assist bylaw enforcement (paid parking program).
- Council approved Park Pass online bookings for the McCurdy Drive parking lot.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for property at 71 Pedwell Point Drive.
- Council supported a Deeming By-law for Lots 2 to 6, Plan 400 (Lindsay).
- Council approved the 2020 Draft Audited Financial Statements as prepared by BDO Canada LLP.
- Council considered entering into an Encroachment Agreement with Miller's Family Camp.
- Council accepted the resignation from Richard Forbes as a Fence Viewer.
- Council approved the purchase of DataFix Election Management System.
- Council supported holding a public meeting on June 28, 2021 for amendments to the Fees and Charges By-law.
- A Minor Variance Application for Plan 433 Lot 85 (Mazzotta) will be presented to the Committee of Adjustment for consideration.

- Council approved a Communication Tower Lease Agreement at 7 Nicholas St.
- Council received a report with respect to short term accommodations.
- Council approved Attainable Housing Task Force and Climate Action Committee minutes.
- Council supported a resolution from Perth County regarding domestic COVID-19 vaccine production and capacity.
- Council received an approved accounts payable voucher for May 2021.
- Under Other Business, Council scheduled a Special Council Meeting for Monday, June 28, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. to discuss short term accommodations. Further, a report will be prepared for Council regarding costs associated with extending hours for bylaw staff in Tobermory.
- Council supported the Silent Walk to honour the 215 lives lost at the former Indian Residential School on Saturday, July 3, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in Lion's Head.
- Several correspondence items were received as information.
- Three by-law were approved: a by-law authorizing an Agreement with Parks Canada, a by-law authorizing an Agreement regarding the Joint Community Safety and Well-Being Plan, and a confirmatory by-law.
- Following a closed session meeting, Mayor McIver advised that direction was provided to staff following a verbal update from the municipal solicitor regarding Shouldice Lake Road.
