



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights July 12, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on June 28, 2021:

- Mike Campbell appeared before Council via Zoom on behalf of the Bruce Peninsula Bird Observatory, Friends of Cabot Head, and Bruce Peninsula Biosphere Association requesting Council's support to convert the Cabot Head Road to a bike path. The CAO will present a report to Council outlining staff workloads associated with contributing to this project.
- Laurie Cochrane, speaking on her own behalf, presented information to Council regarding the Cabot Head Trail proposal and Dyers Bay Community.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 153 Devils Glen Road.
- Council approved No Demand for Services Agreements for property at 10 Mill Point and unnumbered property on Larry's Drive.
- Council supported lifting the Holding Zone for property at 58 Bay Street South and unnumbered property on Larry's Drive.
- Council received a report regarding a COVID-19 Safe Restart Funding Agreement and amended the 2021 Budget to reflect COVID-19 expenditures.
- Council supported passage of By-law 2021-73 (Zoning By-law Amendment File No. Z-2020-043 Blue Heron) at its meeting on July 26, 2021. A site plan control agreement (numerous concerns will be addressed through the site plan control agreement) and consultation with Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) are required prior to passage of the Zoning By-law Amendment.
- Council supported passage of By-law 2021-74 (Zoning By-law Amendment File No. Z-2020-044 Bruce Anchor) at its meeting on July 26, 2021. A site plan control agreement (numerous concerns will be addressed through the site plan control agreement) and consultation with Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) are required prior to passage of the Zoning By-law Amendment.
- Council directed staff to prepare a letter of support to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) with respect to an expanded seating area at Summer House Park Restaurant.

- Council approved entering into an agreement with Grey Sauble Conservation Authority (GSCA) for the delivery of Risk Management Services under Part IV of the Clean Water Act 2006.
- Council received a departmental quarterly report from the CAO as information.
- Council received the approved Accounts Payable Voucher for June 2021.
- Council supported a resolution from the Township of Archipelago regarding Bill 288 banning unencapsulated polystyrene foam.
- Councillor Golden inquired on the status of in person Council meetings. The CAO advised that a report will be presented at the July 26, 2021, Council meeting outlining a reopening plan (subject to COVID-19 status in Grey-Bruce).
- Councillor Myles requested an update on the Lion's Head Arena project. The CAO informed that the Request for Proposals (RFP) for design, consulting, and contract administrating is underway, and the project is planned to commence in the spring of 2022.
- Mayor McIver advised that Bruce County recently approved their Draft Master Transportation Plan which is available on the [County website](#).
- Deputy Mayor Myles asked for a summary of the recent Code of Conduct webinar. No Council members were in attendance.
- In response to a correspondence item, Council supported banning the use and sale of fireworks within the Municipality. A staff report from the Fire Chief will be presented to Council for consideration at a subsequent Council meeting.
- Several other correspondence items were received as information.
- Three by-laws were approved: Fees and Charges By-law, Council Correspondence Policy, and a Confirmatory By-law.
- Council supported the planned fireworks show hosted by the Tobermory Chamber of Commerce for Civic Holiday Weekend (July 31, 2021, at 10:00 p.m.) as the show has been rescheduled from July 1, 2021.
