



## Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights August 23, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on August 23, 2021:

- A public meeting was held regarding short term accommodations (Draft By-law No. 2021-84). Several public comments were noted in support and opposition of the proposed legislation.
- A public meeting was held regarding municipal accommodation tax (Draft By-law No. 2021-83). Public comments were noted in opposition of the proposed legislation.
- Council approved a request from Brian Urbshott for the clean out of the ditch on Pike Bay Road adjacent to lands legally described as Lot 5, Concession 2 East of The Bury Road.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 134 Maple Golf Crescent.
- Council received information regarding an online client management and booking platform for Municipal Harbours and Campground.
- Councils received information with respect to the funding Agreement under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) Community, Culture and Recreation Stream for the Lion's Head and District Community Centre and Arena.
- Council supported appointing the Public Works Manager and the Public Works Supervisor as drainage inspectors and the by-law will be presented for passage on September 13, 2021.
- Council approved a Tile Loan Application submitted by 2748304 Ontario Inc. to install drainage works on Lot 5, Concession 2 EBR, former Township of Eastnor pending funding from OMAFRA.
- Council directed staff to submit comments to the Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) from the Municipality regarding a Development Permit application for 418 Cape Chin Road North.
- Council received correspondence from the Integrity Commissioner, Harold Elston, on closed session meeting protocol.

- Council approved the installation of Electric Vehicle Charging Stations in principle and directed the CAO to commence negotiations with ChargerQuest, inc. and to present a host agreement for Council to review at a later meeting.
- Council deferred the completion of energy audits on municipal buildings pending discussion and approval within the 2022 Budget. The CAO was directed to amend the Parks and Recreation Master Plan Request for Proposals (RFP) to include the completion of energy audits.
- Council approved Climate Action Committee minutes.
- Council supported resolutions from the Municipalities of Chatham-Kent and Leamington.
- Under Other Business, Councillor Mielhausen brought forward a motion for Council to support the installation of a memorial bench in the Stokes Bay area in memory of the late Alex Spurgeon.
- Council discussed concerns with the paid parking program in Lion's Head. The CAO will prepare a report outlining potential solutions at a subsequent Council meeting.
- Several correspondence items were received as information.  
Council approved four by-laws: Lease Agreement with Mary Robbins; Lease Agreement with Bruce Pro Sports; Transfer Payment Agreement Under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) Community, Culture and Recreation Stream (Lion's Head and District Community Centre and Arena); and Confirmatory By-law.
- Following a closed session meeting, Mayor McIver advised that Council received an update from the Municipal Solicitor on potential litigations affecting the Municipality regarding the Big Tub Harbour Citizens Committee and direction was provided to the CAO with respect to personnel/Municipal staffing.
