



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights October 12, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on October 12, 2021:

- Council supported an application for modernization funding to implement a Digital Records Management Project and the allocation of the remaining modernization reserve funds towards the Server and Existing Hardware Upgrade Project.
- Council did not award the Lion's Head Sidewalk Tender to Neptune Security Services in the amount of \$421,877.70. The Lion's Head Sidewalk Project will be reconsidered during the 2022 Budget discussions. The Municipality will submit a request with Bruce County for the continuation of paved shoulders over Bannister Hill in Lion's Head to address drainage and safety concerns at the intersection.
- Council approved the recommendation of the Attainable Housing Committee to award the contract to complete the MNBP Attainable Housing Strategy to SHS Consulting in the amount of \$34,728.00 plus H.S.T., to be completed by the end of March 2022.
- Council received a report regarding dock damage at the Lion's Head Harbour.
- Council received a report including the 2022-2026 Multi-Year Accessibility Plan and will consider passage of the applicable by-law on October 25, 2021.
- Council received a report regarding the 2022 OPP annual billing statement.
- Council directed staff to submit the Municipality's position of no objection to the Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) regarding the Development Permit application for 8 Britain Lake Road.
- Council directed staff to submit the Municipality's comments to the Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) regarding the Development Permit application for 2037 Bruce County Rd 9.
- Council received information regarding business licensing. Staff were directed to prepare an additional report outlining options.
- Council approved the rescheduling of some Council meetings in 2022 due to holidays and the 2022 municipal election.
- Council approved an agreement with Shared Tower Inc. for the construction of a communication tower located at the St. Edmunds Landfill.

- Council approved an agreement with Signum Wireless for the construction of a communication tower at the Lion's Head Fire Hall.
- Council received a report outlining municipal operations in the third quarter of 2021.
- Council approved a proposal from McQueen Galloway Associates in the amount of \$69,900 (excluding HST) for the completion of the Northern Bruce Peninsula Recreation Masterplan and Lion's Head Waterfront Revitalization Study.
- Council received an Accounts Payable Voucher for September 2021.
- Council approved minutes of the Attainable Housing Task Force and Ad Hoc Museum Committee.
- Council supported a resolution from the Municipality of Chatham-Kent regarding OHIP eye care.
- Council requested that the English Public-School Board, English Catholic School Board, French Public-School Board and French Catholic Separate School Board schedule a Professional Development Day on Municipal and School Board Election Day, October 24, 2022.
- Councillor Myles suggested posting a survey on Let's Talk NBP (Bang the Table) to receive public comments regarding paid parking in 2021. Public comments will be provided to Council including revenues for each parking machine location. A Special Council meeting is scheduled for October 25, 2021 regarding parking.
- Councillor Golden commented on the possibility of a Santa Claus parade in 2021.
- Councillor Golden asked that the Municipality request the results of the RFP from Parks Canada regarding Flowerpot Island and Big Tub Harbour.
- Correspondence items were received as information.
- Council passed three by-laws: removal of the holding zone by-law for 22 Scugog Lane, by-law to authorize a lease agreement between Iron League Sports and Promotions and MNBP, and a confirmatory by-law.
- Following a closed session meeting, Mayor McIver advised that Council received information regarding human resources and provided direction to staff.
