



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights October 25, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Special Council Meeting held on October 25, 2021:

- An overview of parking for the 2021 season was presented by staff and Council provided feedback on the following parking locations: North Shore Road Barrow Bay, Channel Road turnaround, end of Channel Road Barrow Bay, Chi-Sin Tub Dik Road, Tamarac causeway, Byron Street, Big Tub Road, Grant Watson, Little Cove Road, McCurdy parking lot, and paid parking in Lion's Head and Tobermory.
- A subsequent Special Council meeting including a Public Meeting for comments was scheduled for Monday, December 13, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. regarding parking within the Municipality.
- A webpage will soon be published on the Municipality's community engagement page, Let's Talk NBP (Bang the Table), to obtain public feedback regarding parking.
- Several correspondence items were received as information.

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on October 25, 2021:

- Council received information regarding restricted acts of Council (lame duck periods).
- Council supported holding a Public Meeting on Monday, November 22, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. with respect to proposed amendments to the Municipality's Fees and Charges By-law. The by-law is scheduled for passage on December 13, 2021 pending changes.
- Council approved the proposal provided by Jim Wilson Chevrolet in the amount of \$52,000 plus HST and licensing for the purchase of a pickup truck.
- Council approved minutes of the Climate Action Committee and Waste Management and Diversion Committee.
- Council supported a resolution from the Township of Adelaide Metcalfe regarding federal and provincial funding for rural infrastructure projects.

- Councillor Golden informed that a Santa Claus parade is planned for December 11, 2021 in Tobermory. There will not be a Santa Claus parade in Lion's Head at this point; however, Santa Claus is planning on visiting the Golden Dawn Nursing Home and Bruce Peninsula District School (BPDS).
- Council received various correspondence items as information and noted that the Municipality is not interesting in purchasing the Rotary Club's pool table.
- Four by-laws were passed: a by-law to establish a Multi-Year Accessibility Plan, a by-law to authorize a lease agreement between MNBP and Shared Tower Inc., a by-law to authorize a lease agreement between MNBP and Signum Wireless, and a confirmatory by-law.
- Following a closed session meeting, Council approved the hiring of a Committee/Licensing Coordinator and provided direction to the CAO to commence union negotiations in early 2022 and extend some current employment contracts.
