



## Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights November 22, 2021

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on November 22, 2021:

- A public meeting was held regarding the 2022 Fees and Charges By-law. Several members of the public spoke on the short term accommodation fees.
- WSP Canada provided an update on the Heron Point Bridge environmental assessment and project status.
- The Bruce County Public Library presented an update on the 2021 season.
- GM BluePlan provided an overview of the Roads and Sidewalks Needs Study that they prepared for the Municipality.
- Council received a report on the 2021/2022 Winter Control Handbook which is scheduled to be adopted by by-law on December 13, 2021.
- Council received a staff report on the Roads and Sidewalks Needs Study as information.
- Council awarded the Comprehensive Zoning By-law 2002-54 Housekeeping project to Cuesta Planning Consultants for \$8,500.00 plus HST.
- Council received a report on the Accessibility Compliance Reporting for 2021.
- Council received a report on tile drainage installed in the former Township of Eastnor.
- Council directed staff to submit the Municipality's position of "no objection" to the County of Bruce with respect to a severance for property in the former Township of Eastnor (Rydall). This was deferred pending clarification on one lot.
- Council selected Simply Voting Inc. to provide telephone and internet voting services for the 2022 Municipal and School Board elections.
- Council directed staff to submit the Municipality's position of "no objection" to the Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) for a development permit in the former Township of Lindsay (Cremenescu).
- Council enacted a by-law to stop up and close an unopened road allowance in the former Township of St. Edmunds.
- Council directed staff to submit the Municipality's position of "no objection" to the County of Bruce for a severance in the former Township of Lindsay (Lederer, Kirchman, and MNBP).

- Council deferred a report from the Integrity Commissioner regarding a complaint lodged against Councillor James Mielhausen pending information from the Integrity Commissioner and/or municipal lawyer.
- Council approved the proposal from Skybuild Energy Inc. for energy audits of municipal facilities in the amount of \$15,000.
- Council approved the Strategic Plan.
- Council approved the HR Services Proposal from Ward and Uptigrove.
- Deputy Mayor Myles requested information regarding costs for finger docks in the Lion's Head Harbour, recording of council meetings, arena renovations, a streetlight that needs repaired, and calling recorded votes for all resolutions.
- The Community Services Manager provided an update on the Winter Concert Series: Tobermory event on December 4, 2021 and Lion's Head event on December 18, 2021.
- Correspondence items were received as information.
- Council passed a by-law to impose special drainage rates upon land in respect of which money is borrowed under the Tile Drainage Act, and a confirmatory by-law.
- Following a closed session meeting, Mayor McIver noted that staff were directed to provide further information.
