



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights March 28, 2022

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on March 28, 2022:

- Mike Campbell provided an update on the Cabot Head Road Project on behalf of the Bruce Peninsula Biosphere Association.
- Council received a report from the Fire Chief on By-law 2022-21 regarding the Sale, Possession, Use, Setting off, Ignition, and/or Discharge of Fireworks within Northern Bruce Peninsula. The new proposed by-law will include a ban on the sale, possession, setting off, discharge, and ignition of family fireworks. Family fireworks and Display fireworks events will require that a permit be obtained at least thirty (30) days prior to the event from the Fire Chief. The first year of implementation will be educating the public on provisions of the by-law.
- Council received a report outlining the Tower Space Licence Agreement with Bayshore Broadcasting at St Edmunds Landfill and Station 10 in Tobermory.
- Council received two reports from the Chief Building Official regarding trailer agreements.
- Council received a report from the Community Services Manager regarding the OMAFRA RED Funding Agreement.
- Council received a report regarding the Meeting Place Pavilion Funding Request.
- Council received a report from the Clerk regarding the appointment of By-law Enforcement Officers.
- Council received a report regarding the proposed amendments and/or additions to the Fees and Charges By-law, By-law 2022-29.
- Council received a report concerning the Bruce County Planning and Economic Development Department, regarding a proposed lot addition.
- Council received a report from the CAO regarding the proposed creation of a Records Management – Administrative Position.
- Council received a report regarding the Tobermory E-Charging Stations. The report was deferred until further information can be obtained.

- Council received a report regarding the Municipal Accommodation Tax Draft Agreement.
- Council received a report regarding the Cabot Head Road Delegation and directed the CAO to sign the work permit order for the Cabot Head Road Construction – Phase 1.
- Council supported a resolution from the City of Barrie.
- Council received a resolution from the City of Waterloo as information.
- Council received several correspondence items as information. Mayor McIver complimented the Northern Bruce Peninsula Fire Department with their efforts assisting Perth County Fire Department's recent search and rescue efforts
- Council directed staff to submit the Municipality's position of not supporting the request for comments from the Ministry of Northern Development, Mines, Natural Resources, and Forestry with regards to floating accommodations
- Council approved three by-laws: Paid Parking and Traffic Control, Appointment of Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, and Confirmatory By-law.
- Following a closed session meeting, Mayor McIver advised that Council received and reviewed the written presentation with regards to the CAO's annual performance review.
