



## Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights June 13, 2022

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on June 13, 2022:

- A Public Meeting was held regarding amendments to Fees and Charges By-law 2022-46 for the addition of Paid Parking Fees and Reserved Parking Fees. No public comments were received.
- Council received a report from the Public Works Manager regarding Revised North Shore Road Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Schedule "B"
- Council received the 2021 Annual Monitoring Reports for the Waste Disposal Sites from the Public Works Manager.
- Council received a report from the Public Works Manager regarding the Isthmus Bay Road Reconstruction Project, Phase 3 Tender Award. The project was awarded to Rydall Contracting at the tender price of \$591,855.00 plus HST.
- Council appointed both Krista Tiernan and Jeff Catley as Acting Deputy Fire Chiefs of the Northern Bruce Peninsula Fire Department.
- Council directed staff to proceed with the purchase of a used 2002 Freightliner Tanker from the Chippewas of Nawash Fire Department for the amount of \$18,000.00.
- Council directed staff to purchase Firefighting Personal Protective Turnout Gear from PPE Solution in the amount of \$4997.00.
- Council supported an exemption of the Tent and Trailer By-law for a family reunion occurring at 67 North Shore Road from July 28, 2022 – August 2, 2022.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 34 Zorra Drive.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 38 Miller Lake Road.
- Council received an update from the Chief Building Official and Cuesta Planning Consultant, Genevieve Scott, regarding Zoning By-law Housekeeping Amendments. Council provided comments on the revised Zoning By-law Housekeeping Amendments report. A Public Meeting presentation is scheduled for Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup> for public comment on the report.

- Council approved a report regarding a Software Licensing Agreement between ParkPass Inc and the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula.
- Council designated the Lion's Head Annual Homecoming Street Dance, to be held on Saturday July 30, 2022, a Municipally Significant Event.
- Council approved Bylaw Enforcement Officer Appointments.
- Council received a report from the Clerk regarding the Cameron Lake Boat Launch off of Beach Road.
- Council received approved Accounts Payable Voucher for May 2022.
- Council approved minutes of the Ad Hoc Museum Committee, Attainable Housing Task Force, Chi Cheemaun Festival Committee and Cemetery Committee.
- Council supported a resolution from the City of Cambridge regarding a Motion from Councillor Liggett – Ontario Must Build it Right the First Time
- Council supported a resolution from the Municipality of Chatham-Kent regarding Retirement Home Funding
- Members of Council discussed potential delegation topics for the AMO (Association of Municipalities Ontario) 2022 conference
- Council received several correspondence items as information.
- Council approved six by-laws: Delegation of Authority for the Processing of Site Plan Control Applications and for the Approval and Execution of Site Plan Control Agreements, Authorization of an Encroachment Agreement for 132A Georgian Drive, Removal of (H) Holding Zone Provision on 57 Main Street, Delegation of Authority to the Chief Administrative Officer for certain acts during the Lame Duck Council period, Appointment of Municipal Law Enforcement Officers and Property Standards Officers, and Confirmatory By-law.
