



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights July 11, 2022

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on July 11, 2022:

- Council approved the minutes of the Special and Regular Council meetings held on Monday, June 27, 2022.
- A presentation was conducted by Northern Bruce Peninsula Community Support Advisory Action Committee (NBPCSAAC) representative, Sharon Colter, in recognition of the MNBP Council's age-friendly initiatives in Northern Bruce Peninsula.
- Council received a delegation from Shawn Hickey regarding necessary repairs for the Johnston's Harbour Boat Launch.
- Council accepted a report from Cuesta Planning Consultant, Genevieve Scott, regarding proposed Zoning By-law 2022-47 (Housekeeping Amendment) and proposed Zoning By-law 2022-55 (Local Plan Amendment).
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 751 East Road.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 33 Hobson's Harbour Drive.
- Council received a report from the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer regarding the Short Form Wording to manage Short-term Accommodations for the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula.
- Council received a report from the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer regarding a request to use ATVs/ORVs on property locally known as Plan M112 Block 50 Sec 3M1112; PCL Plan 1 (Paradise Drive).

- Council received a report from the Treasurer regarding the Lighthouse Fundraiser – Liability Insurance.
 - Council did not approve the requested reimbursement of \$810.00 in Liability Insurance Coverage to the event organizers.

- Council directed staff to submit the Municipality's comments to the Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) regarding the Development Permit application for 2061 Bruce Road 9.
- Council received a report from the Chief Administrative Officer regarding the Employee Survey Summary.
- Council received the Operational Quarterly Report from the Chief Administrative Officer.
- Council Approved the June minutes of the Ad Hoc Museum Committee and Attainable Housing Task Force.
- Council received approved Accounts Payable Voucher for June 2022.
- Council received several correspondence items as information.
- Council deferred the Territory Land Acknowledgement Request from Arlene Kennedy to a later date.
- Council waived the Lion's Head Rotary Hall Rental Fee for the Lakewood Preservation Partnership Non-Profit Corporation for September 24, 2022.
- Councillor Golden commented on the Municipal Accommodation Tax remittance process and it was noted that staff is working with the consultant to streamline the process.
- Deputy Mayor Myles commented on the Municipalities Communication Strategy regarding notifications for surveys and plans requiring public input.
- It was noted that several multi-media platforms are being utilized regarding public outreach.
- Councillor Myles commented on the cell service situation that is affecting the Bruce Peninsula. It was noted that staff is looking into alternative avenues to address the issue.
- Council approved a Confirmatory By-law.
- Following Closed Session, Mayor McIver advised that Council approved previous minutes, Council received an update with regards to the exit interview for the Deputy Fire Chief. In addition, the Lion's Head Harbour Roof Replacement project was discussed, and the municipal solicitor provided a written legal option.
