



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights July 25, 2022

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on July 25, 2022:

- Council approved the minutes of the Council meeting held on Monday, July 11, 2022.
- Council received a delegation from the Grey Bruce Local Immigration Partnership regarding a circle of support for newcomer integration.
- Council awarded the Winter Sand Tender to Hunter Haulage and Excavating Inc. for the amount of \$130,992.00, excluding HST.
- Council received a report from the Public Works Manager regarding a request for speed limit reduction and creation of a 4-way stop in the Cape Hurd Road and Warner Bay Road area.
 - Council approved amendments be made to the speed limit By-law regarding Belrose Road from 80 km/hour to 50 km/hour and Cape Hurd Road, from Highway 6 to McArthur Road, from 60 km/hour to 50 km/hour following the next review of this By-law.
- Council approved the removal of the Holding “H” Zone at 106 Fowlie Road.
- Council approved the removal of the Holding “H” Zone at 60 Howard Bowman Drive.
- Council approved the report from the Clerk regarding the new Records Retention By-law.
- Council approved implementing a new Committee Appointment Policy that was presented by the Clerk.
- Council entered into an Encroachment Agreement to address a proposed retaining wall at 197 Isthmus Bay Road.
- Council approved the report from the Integrity Commissioner as it related to the anonymous complaint lodged against Councillor Golden dated January 25, 2022.
 - It was noted that the results of the Integrity Commissioners investigation found that Council Golden did not contravene the Municipal Conflict of Interest Act (MICIA) and/or sections of the Code of Conduct.

- Council received a report from the Clerk entitled Stop Up and Conveyance of the Unopened Road Allowance By-law.
- Council approved the minutes from the June 14, 2022 meeting of the Climate Action Committee.
- Council passed a Municipal Resolution calling for Gas-Fired Electricity Generation Phase-Out.
- Councillor Golden noted correspondence regarding the right-of-way located at the end of Lindsay Road 30 and individuals engaging in restricted activities.
 - The By-law Department will report to Council at the August 8, 2022 Council meeting regarding this item.
- Councillor Myles inquired regarding the seasonal slip waitlist at the Lion's Head Harbour protocol.
- Councillor Myles noted that correspondence from the Tobermory Chamber of Commerce regarding landscaping proposals will be included on the August 8, 2022 Council agenda, as the material was too late for the agenda deadline for the July 25, 2022 Council meeting.
- Council received several correspondence items as information.
- Council directed staff to respond to correspondence and outline best practices associated with the installation of turtle crossing signs on Municipal roads.
- Council directed the CAO to contact Marydale Ashcroft and Dominik Franken regarding the Harbourside Music Reserve Fund.
- Council directed staff to review the parking concerns in Lion's Head at the end of the parking season and present a report to Council.
- Council approved five by-laws: The Comprehensive Zoning By-law for the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula as it relates to the Housekeeping Amendments, the Official Plan for the Tobermory and Lion's Head Secondary Urban Areas and the Hamlet of Ferndale, the Memorandum of Agreement with participating municipalities, Adoption of the Employee Engagement Policy and a Confirmatory By-law.
- Following Closed Session, Mayor McIver advised that Council approved previous minutes, the CAO provided a report to Council with regards to the Fire Chief 360 Review and a report summary with regards to the exit interview for a Volunteer Firefighter were received.
