



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights November 15, 2022

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on November 15, 2022:

- Council approved the minutes of the Council meeting held on Tuesday, October 11, 2022.
- Mayor McIver was presented with a certificate from the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing recognizing 40 years of involvement with municipal government.
- Council received a report from the GIS/IT Coordinator and adopted an Information Technology Acceptable Use Policy Update.
- Council authorized the Fire Chief to enter into an agreement for the purchase of 20 MSA G1 SCBAs from AJ Stone for the amount of \$270,000.00.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 3 Goderich Point Loop.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 22 Bay Shore Avenue South.
- Council approved a Partial No Demand for Services Site Plan Control Agreement with 28 Rowson's Road.
- Council approved the removal of the Holding (H) Zone for 28 Rowson's Road.
- Council received a report regarding a Deeming By-law for Lots 57, 58, 59 and Block 64, Plan 3M199, Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula (Former Eastnor).
- Council received a report from the Interim Treasurer regarding the 2023 Budget Timetable.
- Council received a report from the Clerk regarding the Appointment of a Committee of Adjustment (COA).
- Council received a report from the Clerk regarding the Appointment of Officers to the Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Authority.
- Council received a report from the Clerk regarding Fees and Charges By-law No. 2023-01 review and it was noted that a public meeting will be held on Monday, November 28, 2022.

- Council received a report from the Clerk regarding Accessibility Initiatives undertaken for the 2022 Municipal Election recap.
