



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Special Council Meeting Highlights November 28, 2022

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Special Council Meeting held on November 28, 2022:

- Council received a report from the Treasurer regarding the 2023 Municipal Funding requests and directed staff as to the allocations to be included in the 2023 Budget.
- Several presentations from members of the community requesting municipal funding were noted:
 - Northern Bruce Peninsula Senior Centre Without Walls – Expansion Project.
 - Pike Bay Community Association – Grant to achieve Incorporation status.
 - Lion’s Head Firefighter Association – Community Light Show.
 - Lion’s Head Promotions Group – support the promotion, organization and sponsorship of various community projects.
 - Walk of Healing/ Truth and Reconciliation Group – Walk of Healing.
 - Crime Stoppers of Grey Bruce Inc – Direct grant funding.
 - The Meeting Place – Community Information and Resource Coordination 2023 and the waiving of fees for the Tobermory Community Centre.
 - Tobermory Pickleball Club – Youth with a Vision Project.
