



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights November 28, 2022

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Committee of Adjustment (COA) Meeting held on November 28, 2022:

- The COA approved the minutes of the Committee of Adjustment Meeting held on October 11, 2022.
- The COA appointed Clerk, Cathy Addison, as Secretary Treasurer.
- The COA appointed Deputy Mayor, Rod Anderson, as COA Chair.
- The COA approved Minor Variance Application A-2022-068 (Fleck)

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on November 28, 2022:

- Council approved the minutes of the Council meeting held on Tuesday, November 15, 2022.
- A public meeting was held for Fees and Charges By-law 2023-01.
 - Council reviewed several new fees included on the proposed By-law such as paid parking fees, marina lift in/ lift out fees, and an annual food truck licensing fee.
 - Council received a remark from a member of the public regarding harbour fees.
- Council received a delegation from Joanne Brouwer-Shouldice and Joel Levesque regarding the Barrow Bay Property Owners Association Break Wall Reconstruction and Channel Dredging/ Shoreline Erosion Control Project requesting financial assistance.
- Council received a report from the Public Works Manager regarding a 2022/2023 Winter Control Handbook.
- Council approved a Trailer Agreement for 1084 Dorcas Bay Road.
- Council approved a Partial No Demand for Services Site Plan Control Agreement for 11 Floods Drive.
- Council received a report from the Clerk regarding the Establishment of a Code of Conduct for Members of Council and Local Boards.

- A motion was carried to remove the definition of family included within the proposed Code of Conduct.
- Council received a report from the CAO and authorized an agreement with Parks Canada to make a grant to the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula for the Davis Settler Cabin Project.
- Councillor Golden inquired regarding extending an invitation to MP, Alex Ruff, and MPP, Rick Byers, to attend a Council meeting regarding Council's priorities for the Municipality.
- Council received several correspondence items as information.
- Council supported a resolution from Northumberland County regarding streamlining governing legislation for Physicians in Ontario.
- Council approved four by-laws: A By-law to appoint officers to the Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Authority, a By-law to establish winter minimum maintenance standards for Municipal roadways, a By-law to authorize an agreement with Parks Canada and a Confirmatory By-law.
- Following Closed Session, Mayor McIver advised that Council approved previous minutes, Council were provided a verbal update on the Municipal Treasurer by the CAO and Municipal Solicitor, Nicolas Lovell presented an overview of the municipal legal cases.
