



Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Council Meeting Highlights October 23, 2023

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on October 23, 2023:

- Council approved the minutes of the Council Meeting from October 10, 2023.
- Council received a delegation from the Municipal Innovation Council (MIC) regarding project updates.
- Council received a delegation from FoodCycler regarding the FoodCycler Food Waste Diversion Pilot Results.
- Council authorized Lotowater Technical Services Inc. to complete the maintenance and inspection work on the Tobermory Community Centre Well in the amount of \$23,200.00.
- Council directed staff to submit the position of no comment to the Bruce County Planning Department regarding a Zoning Amendment for 7142 Highway 6.
- Council directed staff to submit the position of no comment to the Bruce County Planning Department regarding a severance for the property legally described as no civic address, Concession 12 EBR Part Lot 131(Eastnor) Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula.
- Council received a report from the Chief Administrative Officer regarding the Lion's Head Shuttle.
 - Council directed staff to commence negotiations with Golden Dawn Senior Home for the continuation of the Lion's Head Shuttle Services for 2024.
- Council received the Q3 Quarterly Report from the Chief Administrative Officer as information.
- Council approved the minutes of the June 8, 2023, Climate Action and Waste Diversion Committee Meeting.
- Councillor Golden inquired regarding the annual review of the Short-term Accommodation Program.
 - It was noted that a report will be included on the November 27, 2023, Council agenda.
- Council received several correspondence items as information.

- Council supported a resolution from the City of Thunder Bay regarding Intimate Partner Violence.
- Council supported a resolution from the Township of Archipelago regarding a request to the province to declare gender-based violence and intimate partner violence an epidemic in Ontario.
- Council supported a resolution from the Township of Archipelago regarding cigarette producer responsibility.
- Council supported a resolution from the City of Burlington regarding provincial legislation for third-party short-term rental companies.
- Council approved a Confirmatory By-law.
