The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Special Council Meeting held on August 28, 2023:

- Council participated in a Zoning By-law Workshop which was led by the Chief Building Official and the Building/Planning Administrative Assistant.

The following is a summary of the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on August 28, 2023:

- Council approved the minutes of the Council Meeting from August 14, 2023.
- Council received a delegation from Bruce Peninsula Hospice Manager, Nancy Forgrave, regarding the Bruce Peninsula Hospice's In-Home and Grief and Bereavement Services Updates.
- Council awarded Tender PW 2023-04, Winter Sand, to Hunter Haulage and Excavating Inc. for \$126,071.00, excluding HST.
- Council approved and authorized the Treasurer to redirect \$30,000 in 2023 capital project funding to the repair/replacement of equipment at the Tobermory Harbour and MNR Rental House.
- Council deferred the recommendation included within a report from the Parks and Facilities Manager regarding the requirement for Tobermory and Lion's Head Harbour's electrical upgrades until further information can be obtained.
- Council received a report from the Parks and Facilities Manager regarding The Meeting Place Building Structural Assessment and Designated Substances Survey Reports.
 - Council approved the replacement of the two rooftop HVAC units as per the Municipal Procurement Policy.
- Council received a report from the Parks and Facilities Manager regarding an update to the Lion's Head Harbour Policy Manual.
- Council received a report from the Parks and Facilities Manager regarding a proposed Memorial Bench and Tree Program Policy.

- Council renewed the lease for the Food Concession Booth operation at the Lion's Head and District Community Centre and Arena with Mary Robbins in the amount of \$3,000.00 per year, excluding HST for a two-year period.
- Council received a report from the Treasurer regarding Tile Drainage Debenture 2023-68.
- Council received a report from Bruce County Senior Development Planner, Jenn Burnett, regarding Official Plan Amendment L-2023-008 & Zoning By-law Amendment Z-2023-030 for Escarpment Heights (Agent Ron Davidson).
- Council supported the passage of By-law No. 2023-64, being a by-law to amend the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Comprehensive Zoning By-law No. 2002-54, as amended Escarpment Heights Inc. – Owner-Adam Robins – 18 Maple Golf Crescent.
- Council supported the passage of By-law No. 2023-63, being a by-law to amend the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Official Plan for Lands Described as PL 3M104 BLK 50 (St Edmunds), Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula – 18 Maple Golf Crescent.
- Council supported the passage of By-law No. 2023-73, Being a By-Law to Assume and Declare a Parcel of Land in the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula as a Public Highway Part of Lot 23 Concession 3 WBR being on Registered Plan 3M-257 - 11 Lots - Trillium Crossing- Phase 3.
- Council supported the passage of By-law No. 2023-74, Being a By-Law to Assume and Declare a Parcel of Land in the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula as a Public Highway Part Lots 23 and 24 Concession 4 WBR on Registered Plan 3M-263 and Blocks 13 and 14 being on Registered Plan 3M-257 Trillium Crossing Road - Phase 4.
- Council received several correspondence items as information.
- Council approved four by-laws: A By-law to Adopt Amendment No. L-2023-008 to the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Official Plan for Lands Described as 18 Maple Golf Cres, A by-law to amend the Municipality of Northern Bruce Peninsula Zoning By-law 2002-54, as amended. (Escarpment Heights Inc.- Adam Robins), A by-law imposing special annual drainage rates upon land in respect of which money is borrowed under the Tile Drainage Act, and a Confirmatory By-law
